**New Business**

- Rose received a form from the US Post Office that needs to be completed and returned in order for us to keep our post office box. It included info like her license number, address, etc. A 2<sup>nd</sup> person was needed on the form, Tony volunteered his info for this.
- Rose saw in the CF paper that the Arts Festival is having their event the same day at our 2 day show. And the advertisement said that people could park in the fairgrounds. Rose contacted the Secretary of the Fair Board and the Arts Festival does not have approval to use the fairgrounds. Just in case, Allison Pedersen will make "Horse Show/Horse Trailer Parking Only" signs on poster board to be placed at both entrances.
- Rose contacted Secretary of the Fair Board. They will make sure that they have the sentence to serve people remove the posts and ropes this year.
- Rose suggested that Tony and Brian contact the Fair Board members since they are our Fair Board representatives – mention to them our concern about the Arts Festival parking and verify that the sentence to serve program will remove the posts and ropes this year.
- Rose is wondering where the 2<sup>nd</sup> cash box may be? Tony thought maybe it was in the shed. She reminded Tony that at the youth show he must take out the \$50 startup cash prior to giving the money to the board.

- It was decided that we will NOT be providing food at the Ranch Rodeo because of lack of volunteers and a net loss last year. \*\*\*This wasn't discussed at the meeting, but was discussed via email by the officers on 5/27 because an answer was needed prior to the next CF meeting.

At 8:10 pm a motion was received and seconded to close the meeting. Approved by all!

The next CFRR meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 22nd at 7:00 pm at the arena! If it's raining, it will be held at St. Ansgars Church. If the location is changed to the church, an email will be sent out by 3 pm that day notifying all members.
